We are Better Together

"A life that is without problems may literally be more hopeless than one that always verges on despair."

Although many of us know we are better together, because we get a better return for our work... A three fold cord is not easily broken, we also know that relationships can be messy and difficult at times. And when things get messy it may be tempting just to walk away and cut off the relationship. This happens at many levels from friendships, to colleagues at work, and in marriages. Rather than walking away and cutting off, it is often important to establish healthy boundaries (this may be required from time to time). However, in Scripture, we see that God often allows us to go through difficult relational situations so that we can GROW and MATURE.

This is why COVENANTAL COMMITMENT is so important. Ruth refused to leave her mother in law Naomi even though there was seemingly no hope. Elisha stuck with Elijah until the very end when Elijah was taken up to heaven in a chariot of fire and whirlwind. Because of their commitment to each other and their perseverance, they all went to HIGHER Level! God is not interested in your comfort alone, but also in you becoming more Christlike in character (the Imageo Dei = the Image of God) and fulfilling the (Missio Dei) the mission of God.
