

Proverbs 3:5-10 TPT

Trust in the Lord completely, and do not rely on your own opinions. With all your heart rely on him to guide you, and he will lead you in every decision you make. [6] Become intimate with him in whatever you do, and he will lead you wherever you go.

During the worship night yesterday evening, a word of encouragement was released to ABIDE IN ME (John 15). When we abide in Him we can trust in him... He already knows what's on our hearts even before we pray. When we talk to him in prayer, we are actually the beneficiaries because we can cast our cares and worries upon Him because He cares for us.

Abiding also means we do not rely on our own wisdom, perspectives, opinions and strength. We can rely on the strength of the Holy Spirit who will lead us into all truth. So let us confess and surrender our thoughts and ways to Him. Let us begin to speak the words of life.

Let us become intimate with Him. Invite Him into every part of our thoughts and lives today.

As we pray today, let us personalise this passage of scripture and declare it aloud:

Lord, I put my trust in You... You are the light and my salvation. I will not rely on my own opinions and thoughts. Please guide and lead me in every decision I need to make. Lord, be with me. I want to know you intimately. I don't know it all, for wisdom comes when I adore You with my undivided devotion and avoid everything that's wrong. Then I will find the healing refreshment my body and spirit longs for. I glorify you Lord with all my wealth, honoring you with my very best, with every increase that comes to me. Then every dimension of my life will overflow with blessings from an uncontainable source of inner joy!
