As we prepare for our season of Prayer and Fasting starting on 26th May to 14th June- The BATTELCRY, we want to establish and equip you with some powerful weapons. Declaring God's promises even in the midst of difficulties and pains – is a powerful scriptural and spiritual weapon for our daily victory in life. Believing, confessing and declaring God's Words and promises over your life and circumstances will give you victory always – no matter how bad things may seem.

Romans 10:8 - The message is very close at hand; It is on your lips and in your heart.

Romans 10: 9-10 - And that message is the very message about faith that we preach: If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

Today, lets make some declarations from Isaiah 41:8-10 and 43:1- speak this out aloud!

Isaiah 41:8f

I am a servant of God.

God has CHOSEN me, He has called me and I CHOOSE Christ and His ways.

He CREATED me.

He FORMED me.

I will NOT FEAR, for God's Spirit is with me. He promises never to leave me or forsake me.

I will NOT be discouraged because God is my God.

He will strengthen me and HELP me.

He will HOLD ME UP with His victorious right hand.

I declare that all my enemies will lie in confusion and humiliation. All their plans against me, my family, my church will come to nothing in Jesus name! Those who accuse and attack me will come to nothing for the LORD holds me by His right hand.

I have been RANSOMED by His Blood.

Jesus PAID my ransom in FULL when He died on the CROSS.

He Rose from the dead, He is ALIVE.

The same spirit that raised CHRIST from the dead is alive in me.

He knows me by name.

And He calls me by name (insert your name).

I am HIS.

When I go through the waters of difficulty, I will not drown because HE is WITH ME.
